COMMUNITY OUTREACH

2013 was the first full year that New Life Community Outreach operated with financial independence from New Life United Methodist Church. The generous contributions from volunteers and donors like you made this a year full of exciting investments and new ways to serve the needs of our community. Highlights from this year included:

New Life Community Outreach:

- Purchased a new 15 passenger van to continue the ability to transport neighbors to our facilities to receive care from NLCO outreach ministries.
- Raised over \$33,000 through the Buckeye Tailgate and Bluegrass Festival fundraisers.
- Received our first corporate grant for \$3,500.

Breakfast Outreach:

- Served over 26,500 free meals.
- Received \$75,000 in food donations from corporate and neighborhood partners.
- Purchased over \$17,000 in food to supplement donations.

Health & Wellness Outreach:

- Licensed physicians provided free health services to an average of 44 patients every Sunday morning.
- Implemented a prescription drug program with Kroger to allow patients of the health clinic to obtain needed medications at no charge to the patient.

Clothing Room Outreach:

- Served over 16,500 neighbors in need (includes repeat visitors to the Clothing Room.)
- Reached 1,070 people that had never before visited the Clothing Room.
- Received over \$475,000 worth of donated clothing that has been or will be provided to our neighbors in need at no charge.
- Hired a part time Clothing Room steward to oversee operations.
- Purchased over \$11,000 in clothing items of need to supplement donations.
- Invested an additional \$2,500 to stock the clothing room with hats, gloves, coats and thermals to provide to our neighbors during the cold winter months.
